Admiral Jonathan Greenert

Former Chief of Naval

Jonathan W. Greenert is a retired four-star admiral and the former Chief of Naval Operations, the senior military position within the Department of the Navy. In this role, which he held from 2011 – 2015, Admiral Greenert was responsible for the command, utilization of resources and operating efficiency of the Navy. He also served as a member of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and as the principal naval advisor to the President and Secretary of the Navy.

As Chief of Naval Operations, Admiral Greenert centered his efforts on improving the deployment and capabilities of US operations technology around the world, as well as sharpening the Navy's ability to operate in an increasingly contested maritime environment. He is a renowned expert on budgetary and financial management issues, cybersecurity and the Asia-Pacific region.

Over the course of his distinguished 41-year career in the Navy, Admiral Greenert held a variety of senior roles around the world, including Commander, US Forces Micronesia; Deputy Commander, US Pacific Fleet; Deputy Comptroller, Dept. of the Navy; Chief Financial Officer, US Navy; Commander, US Seventh Fleet (Asia-Pacific); Commander, US Atlantic Fleet; and Vice Chief of Naval Operations. He is a recipient of many awards including the Distinguished Service Medal, Defense Superior Service Medal and Legion of Merit.

Admiral Greenert is a graduate of the US Naval Academy, where he majored in Ocean Engineering, and was graduated and commissioned an Ensign in the US Navy in June 1975. He completed studies in nuclear engineering and entered the nuclear submarine force, and was subsequently certified to operate, manage and supervise naval nuclear reactor systems. His service in submarines culminated in command of the submarine USS Honolulu (SSN 718) in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii.

Admiral Greenert retired from military service in October 2015 and currently serves as a consultant, adviser and member of corporate boards. He joined UBS Americas Advisory Council in April 2016.

Admiral Greenert and his wife Darleen have been married for over 41 years, and are blessed with three grown children, Jonathan, Brian and Sarah; a grandson, Leland; and a Golden Retriever, Maggie. He is a native of Butler, Pennsylvania.
